IMMUNIZATIONS NEEDED TO START 7TH GRADE

Students entering 7th grade for the 2011-2012 school year will be required to show proof that they have received the following shots:

- <u>1.</u> <u>Tdap</u> (tetanus, diphtheria and acellular pertussis)
- 2. Meningococcal
- 3. Second varicella

(history of chicken pox is acceptable in lieu of either dose of varicella vaccine)

Please provide a copy of the shot record to the clinic. Processing records takes time and the nurse does not work in the summer, so the earlier the shot record is received the better. By law, students will not be allowed to attend classes without evidence of having received these immunizations.
